A complaint against a district judge was dismissed with a warning. The JCC found that the judge, during a telephonic motion hearing, violated Code of Judicial Conduct Canon 3B(4), which requires judges to be patient and dignified to litigants, jurors, witnesses, lawyers, and others with whom the judge deals in an official capacity. The JCC found that the judge's conduct constituted troubling but relatively minor misbehavior for which no public sanction was warranted.
